

SUMMER Full-Day Camps

Cornelius Parks & Recreation offers eight weeks of full-day camps designed to provide children with a positive, safe, and fun environment throughout the summer.

Due to popular demand, we have expanded this camp offering to two locations. Ages 8-12 will be housed at Bailey Road Recreation Center and ages 6-7 (must have completed Kindergarten) will be housed at JV Washam Recreation Center.

Each week will feature at least one offsite field trip and a special onsite guest or other surprises among jam-packed days of camp activities. Excluding field trip days, campers will be divided into pre-designated, age-specific groups for activity rotations throughout the day. Meals are not provided unless otherwise noted; each camper must bring his/her own nut-free lunch and nut-free snacks, a large refillable water bottle, and tennis or other closed-toe shoes to camp daily. The camp day will run from 7:30a-5:30p. Though campers may be dropped off later or picked up earlier on most days, there are no earlier drop-off or later pickup options.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

It is the mission of the Town of Cornelius Parks & Recreation Department (CPRD) to provide recreational opportunities for all residents of Cornelius, so financial assistance is offered to residents of Cornelius only. The number of scholarships available is limited, depending on the space available, and will be given on a firstcome, first-served basis. Generally, scholarships are offered for approximately ten percent (10%) of the spaces available. CPRD will determine the number of scholarships that are available for each program. After the allotment of spaces has been filled, staff will consider all applications on a case-by-case basis.

All residents will be required to pay a portion of the registration fee for each program. Full scholarships are not available through the Town of Cornelius for any CPRD activity. If a child qualifies for reduced price meals through the CMS Lunch Assistance program guidelines, they may be eligible for assistance of up to fifty (50%) of the published fee. If a child qualifies for free meals through the CMS Lunch Assistance program guidelines, they may be eligible for assistance of up to seventy-five (75%) of the published fee. Applicants will be required to provide proof of eligibility for financial assistance.

REFUND POLICY

In the event that a child cannot participate in a camp session in which he/she is registered, a 90% refund will be issued when requested by May 27, 2024. Beginning May 28, 2024, any cancellations made at least two weeks prior to the start of the registered camp week will receive a 75% refund. If less than two weeks advance notice is given. a 50% refund will be issued. Once a camp has begun, no refund will be given. Please allow up to 30 days for refund processing. Additionally, if a child wishes to transfer from a camp in which he/she is registered to another available camp, a minimum of seven (7) days advance notice

Additionally, if a camp is canceled by CPRD, participants will receive full refunds or department credits, or prorated refunds or department credits, for the portion of camp that cannot be offered.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Generally, all fees are due upon registration, though a payment plan is available for Full Day Camps only. All camp registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. WEATHER CONCERNS FOR OUTDOOR CAMPS

If the weather is questionable, please check the rainout hotline at 704-896-2460 x290 for important information regarding the status of camp, which may indicate camp cancellations or possible alternative outdoor locations for the day. The hotline will be updated by 8 a.m. each morning. CPRD has extremely limited access to alternative indoor camp locations. For any camp day canceled due to weather, CPRD will issue a prorated credit onto the customer's account for future use.

While at camp, if the weather conditions should change and be deemed unsafe to continue activities in the open, participants at an outdoor camp will typically take cover at a nearby park shelter and camp will resume there. Activities may then include sport-related discussions and/or a group game that can be played in a smaller area. In these cases, we will update the rainout hotline.

MISCELLANEOUS

All campers will receive one T-shirt per summer, regardless of the number of camps they attend.

CPRD strives to offer a minimum camper to instructor ratio of 10:1. Camp minimum enrollment must be met in order to hold each camp. Camp dates, times, locations, instructors, and/or activity plans are subject to change with limited notice. The Town of Cornelius, camp instructors, and host locations are not responsible for any lost or stolen personal items brought to camp.
