WARNING OF RISK: Recreational activities are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental, and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning, and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Depending on the activity, participants must understand that certain risks, dangers, and injuries due to inclement weather, slips and falls, poor skill level or conditioning, carelessness, horseplay, unsportsmanlike conduct, premises defects, inadequate or defective equipment, inadequate supervision, instruction, and all other circumstances inherent to indoor and outdoor recreational activities exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Cornelius Parks and Recreation Department to guarantee absolute safety.

CPRD WAIVER: In consideration of the acceptance of this entry for my child, I hereby waive and release the Town of Cornelius, The Cornelius Parks & Recreation Department, the camp instructors, sponsors, volunteers, and any other persons associated with this event of all responsibility and liability of any nature whatsoever as it concerns any/all injuries, sickness, or damages incurred from my child's participation. Further, I certify that my child is physically capable of participating in the activities for which he/she has registered. I give my permission for the free and unrestricted use of my child's picture in any telecast, broadcast, or written account of this program. I acknowledge my email address will be used exclusively by the Town of Cornelius for the purpose of sharing related information regarding this or other programs and will not be shared with any other parties.

SC REFUND POLICY: In the event that a child cannot participate in a camp session in which he/she is registered, a 90% refund will be issued when requested by May 27, 2024. Beginning May 28, 2024, any cancellations made at least two weeks prior to the start of the registered camp week, will receive a 75% refund. If less than two weeks advance notice is given, a 50% refund will be issued. Once a camp has begun, no refund will be given. Please allow up to 30 days for refund processing. Additionally, if a child wishes to transfer from a camp in which he/she is registered to another available camp, a minimum of seven (7) days advance notice is required. Additionally, if a camp is cancelled by CPRD, participants will receive full refunds or department credits, or pro-rated refunds or department credits, for the portion of camp that cannot be offered. I have read and agree to this refund policy.

BEHAVIORAL POLICY: It is very important that both parents and campers are aware of both the rules and subsequent consequences. All rules must be obeyed for the safety of everyone. If a participant chooses not to follow the camp rules, the parent will be asked to work together with the supervisor and the child to solve the problem. Parents will be notified of any problems that their child may cause in the program. RULES: Campers must follow directions of all camp staff and be considerate and respectful to other campers, their surroundings and other's property. Campers should keep hands and feet to self. Fighting, hitting, kicking, use of profanity or name-calling will not be tolerated and could result in immediate suspension. CONSEQUENCES & PROCEDURES: 1) Verbal warning by counselor. 2) Camper will be placed in time-out for five to fifteen minutes, depending on age of camper. 3) Verbal conference with camper, counselor and Camp Director. 4) Written disciplinary report completed and put on file by Camp Director. Parents will be notified, in writing, within one day regarding the written disciplinary report. 5) Two written disciplinary reports on one camper will result in, at minimum, a one-to-two-day suspension from camp. Days suspended will run concurrently. No refunds will be given in case of suspension. 6) Three written disciplinary reports will result in dismissal from camp for the remainder of the summer. No refunds will be given in cases of dismissal. 7) Depending on the severity of the offense, any and all steps in the Consequences & Procedures may be eliminated and or combined.

LATE PICKUP/LATE FEE POLICY: Each child must be signed in/out each day by a parent or guardian, before and after camp. Parents or guardians may sign in campers up to 15 minutes prior to any camp starting time, when we will have camp staff on site. Parents or guardians may sign out campers up to 10 minutes after any camp ending time. Late Fees: We will allow a 5-minute grace period to pick up campers beyond the 10-minute camp pickup window noted above. If campers are picked up after the specified grace period, parents/account holders will be assessed a late fee of \$1 per minute, with start time for charges commencing at conclusion of the 10-minute camp pickup window. Parents will be notified of the late fee and payment will be accepted by phone, online or in-person.
