PAYMENT PLAN: For Summer Day Camps only, we offer the option for you to pay a minimum of 50% of the fees due upon registration.
NON-RESIDENTS: 1st payment will be \$165.00 per camp per child, which is 50% of resident rate plus full \$60.00 non-resident fee; 2nd payment will be \$105.00. **Final balances for all camps are due by May 20, 2022**, or registrations will be cancelled and deposits will be forfeited. Of course, the payment plan is optional, and you may choose to pay the full amount due at the time of registration.

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WAIVER: In consideration of the acceptance of this entry for my child, I hereby waive and release the Town of Cornelius, the camp instructors, sponsors, volunteers, and any other persons associated with this event of all responsibility and liability of any nature whatsoever as it concerns any/all injuries, sickness, or damages incurred from my child's participation. I certify that my child is physically fit and capable of participating in the activities for which he/she has registered. I give my permission for the free and unrestricted use of my child's picture in any telecast, broadcast, or written account of this program. I acknowledge my email address will be used exclusively by the Town of Cornelius for the purpose of sharing related information regarding this or other programs and will not be shared with any other parties.

REFUND POLICY: In the event that a child cannot participate in a camp session in which he/she has registered, a 90% refund will be issued when requested by May 29, 2022. Beginning May 30, 2022, any cancellations made at least two weeks prior to the start of the registered camp week, will receive a 75% refund. If less than two weeks advance notice is given, a 50% refund will be issued. Once a camp has begun, no refund will be given. Please allow up to 30 days for refund processing. Additionally, if a child wishes to transfer from a camp in which he/she has registered to another available camp, a minimum of seven (7) days advance notice is required.

BEHAVIORAL POLICY: It is very important that both parents and campers are aware of both the rules and subsequent consequences. All rules must be obeyed for the safety of everyone. If a participant chooses not to follow the camp rules, the parent will be asked to work together with the supervisor and the child to solve the problem. Parents will be notified of any problems that their child may cause in the program. **RULES:** Campers must follow directions of all camp staff and be considerate and respectful to other campers, their surroundings and other's property. Campers should keep hands and feet to self. Fighting, hitting, kicking, use of profanity or name-calling will not be tolerated and could result in immediate suspension. **CONSEQUENCES & PROCEDURES:** 1) Verbal warning by counselor. 2) Camper will be placed in time-out for five to fifteen minutes, depending on age of camper. 3) Verbal conference with camper, counselor and Camp Director. 4) Written disciplinary report completed and put on file by Camp Director. Parents will be notified, in writing, within one day regarding the written disciplinary report. 5) Two written disciplinary reports on one camper will result in, at minimum, a one-to-two-day suspension from camp. Days suspended will run concurrently. No refunds will be given in case of suspension. 6) Three written disciplinary reports will result in dismissal from camp for the remainder of the summer. No refunds will be given in cases of dismissal. 7) Depending on the severity of the offense, any and all steps in the Consequences & Procedures may be eliminated and or combined.



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LATE PICKUP/LATE FEE POLICY: Each child must be signed in/out each day by a parent or guardian, before and after camp. Parents or guardians may sign in campers beginning at 7:30 am, when we will have camp staff onsite. Parents or guardians should sign out campers by camp ending time, which is 5:30 pm. Late Fees: We will allow a 5-minute grace period to pick up campers beyond 5:30 pm. If campers are picked up after the specified grace period, parents/account holders will be assessed a late fee of \$1 per minute, with start time for charges commencing at 5:30 pm.

**WAIVER/RELEASE FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES INCLUDING COVID-19
FOR PARTICIPANTS OF MINOR AGE (UNDER AGE 18 AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION) AND
PROGRAM MODIFICATION ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT: In consideration of my child/ward being allowed to participate in the Town of Cornelius summer camps program and related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my child/ward's participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation as regards protection against infectious diseases. If, however, I observe any unusual or significant hazard during my presence, I will remove myself and my child/ward from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Town of Cornelius, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I have read this Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without any inducement. I also certify that I, as parent/guardian, with legal responsibility for this participant, have read and explained the provisions in this waiver/release to my child/ward, including the risks of presence and participation and his/her personal responsibilities for adhering to the rules and regulations for protection against communicable diseases. Furthermore, my child/ward understands and accepts these risks and responsibilities. I for myself, my spouse, and child/ward do consent and agree to his/her release provided above for all the Releasees, and myself, my spouse, and child/ward do release and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees for any and all liabilities incident to my minor child's/ward's presence or participation in these activities as provided above, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THEIR NEGLIGENCE, to the fullest extent provided by law.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF POTENTIAL PROGRAM MODIFICATION: I fully understand and accept that the 2022 summer camps provided by Cornelius Parks & Recreation will be based on the most current COVID-19 directives or guidance in place at the time of each camp offering. Program modifications MAY include, but not be limited to, socially distanced camp activities, modified lesson plans and activities, location changes, modified drop-off/pick-up procedures, and lower enrollment maximums. Additionally, I acknowledge that all participants attending any camp held indoors OR outdoors MAY be required to use personal protective equipment such as masks (with any requirements in effect for campers, staff, and instructors), depending on the local, federal, or state guidance at the time that camp occurs. Regardless of any requirements, if parents or legal guardians feel most comfortable with their campers wearing a mask, they are welcome to do so. Campers must provide their own masks.
