SPLASH PAD RULES

- The splash pad is unsupervised.
- All children under the age of 12 must have adult supervision at all times.
- Use caution as the pad surface may be slippery when wet; shoes are recommended.
- At first sight of lightning or sound of thunder, immediately move to a safe place away from the splash pad.
- The splash pad may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance, or other operational concerns.
- Do not use the splash pad until at least 30 minutes have passed after a thunder or lightning event.
- Bathing suits, or shorts and t-shirt, must be worn at all times within the splash pad.
- All apparel worn in the splash pad must be clean prior to entry.
- All non-potty-trained children must wear a swim diaper.

The following activities and items are **prohibited** on the splash pad:

- Skateboards, skates, hoverboards, rollerblades, scooters, bicycles, or similar recreation equipment
- Glass, metal objects, soap and all materials that could create hazardous conditions
- Climbing, pushing, hanging, standing, and sitting on or obstructing water features
- Pets/animals, except service animals as defined by the U.S. Department of Justice
- Toys including water guns, water pistols, and other water emitting toys
- Drinking splash pad water, spitting, or spouting water from mouth
- Throwing objects onto the splash pad or in adjacent areas
- Changing diapers on or near the splash pad
- Persons having a contagious disease
- Mud, sticks, leaves, or debris
- Food, beverages, or gum
- Running or rough play
