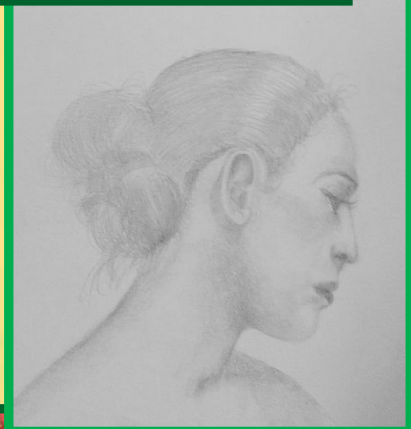
### All Level Wheel & Handbuilding
