**WELCOME**

The Cornelius PARC Department is offering the 2021 Junior Disc Golf League for boys and girls ages 7-15. The purpose of this league is to provide a fun program that will reinforce aerobic exercise, mental stimulation and individual skills development.

This information packet has been prepared to help guide you through the program.

**REGISTRATION DATES & FEES**

Registration opens on Monday, April 5 for Cornelius residents. Registration for the general public will open on Monday, April 12. Registration closes on Sunday, April 25.

Fees: Cornelius resident \$25 and non-resident \$35, per participant.

If paying by check, make all checks payable to: Cornelius PARC Department.

**SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarship opportunities are available to Cornelius residents on a limited basis and are typically aligned with the CMS Free & Reduced Lunch guidelines. To apply for a scholarship, begin by completing the scholarship application form.

**REFUND POLICY**

In the event that a child cannot participate in the Junior Disc Golf League for in which he/she is registered, the refund policy is as follows:

- A 75% refund will be issued when requested by Sunday, April 18.
- A 50% refund will be issued when requested by Sunday, April 25.
- Beginning Monday, April 26, no refunds will be issued.

**DIVISIONS**

Participants who are within the ages of 7-15, will register for either the Introductory Division or the Intermediate Division. The Introductory Division is for players with very little experience with the game of disc golf and who are not yet ready for a competitive format. The Intermediate Division is for players who are already familiar with the rules and etiquette of disc golf and are looking to be challenged.

## **EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES**

Participants should have the following with them for league play:

- Bring their own discs suitable for disc golf.
- Wear comfortable clothing such as athletic shorts, loose fitting t-shirt and tennis shoes.
- Water bottle and sun screen are highly recommended.

## **GROUP “FOURSOME” ASSIGNMENTS**

Players will be randomly grouped by age for the first week of league play. Each week of subsequent league play players will be grouped by their score from previous weeks.

## **LOCATION(S)**

League activities are scheduled to take place at:

- Bailey Road Park, 11900 Bailey Road
  - Disc golf course is adjacent to the tennis courts.

Generally, our goal is to host all league activities at Bailey Road Park but availability or other factors beyond our control may necessitate the use of the our Robbins Park disc golf course, which is located at:

- Westmoreland Athletic Complex, 8430 Westmoreland Road
  - Disc golf course is adjacent to field #4 at Westmoreland Athletic Complex.

If a change in location is warranted, the PARC Department will communicate the change in venue promptly.

## **LEAGUE ROUNDS**

League rounds for all divisions will begin on Thursday, April 29.

- Introductory Division will end on Thursday, May 20.
- Intermediate Division will end on Thursday, May 27.

For all divisions, players will be scheduled to participate in four (4) rounds (once per week). For the Intermediate Division only, there will be an end of season tournament.

The number of rounds, dates, times, and locations, for all divisions, are subject to change based upon total registrations and weather conditions.

The Athletic Program Manager, or his designee, reserves the right to modify the total number of rounds and regular season and post-season schedules as needed so that the season can end in a reasonable amount of time.

League rounds may also be scheduled on other nights of the week in the event of schedule changes or postponements. Please be prepared to play on different weeknights.
