FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:

The performance of the Agreement by either party shall be subject to force majeure, including but not limited to acts of God, fire, flood, natural disaster, war or threat of war, acts or threats of terrorism, civil disorder, unauthorized strikes, governmental regulation or advisory, recognized health threats as determined by the World Health Organization, the Centers for Disease Control, or local government authority or health agencies (including but not limited to the health threats of COVID-19, H1N1, or similar infectious diseases), curtailment of transportation facilities, or other similar occurrence beyond the control of the parties or where any of them make it illegal, impossible, inadvisable, or commercially impracticable to hold the Event or to fully perform the terms of the Agreement. The Agreement may be cancelled by either party, without liability, damages, fees, or penalty, and any unused deposits or amounts paid shall be refunded, for any one or more of the above reasons, by written notice to the other party.

INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE:

The VENDOR shall provide and maintain at its own expense during the term of this Agreement the following program(s) of insurance covering its operations. Such insurance shall be provided by insurer(s) satisfactory to the TOWN and evidence of such insurance satisfactory to the TOWN shall be delivered to the TOWN on or before the effective date of this Agreement. Such evidence shall specifically identify this Agreement and list the Town as an additional insured.

VENDER must provide in advance of service and satisfactory to the Town, a valid Certificate of Insurance, including a minimum of \$1,000,000 in coverage per incident or occurrence. **Certificate of Insurance must list the Town of Cornelius (21445 Catawba Avenue, Cornelius, NC) as an Additional Insured and be attached to this agreement.**

Commercial General Liability: Bodily injury and property damage liability as shall protect the VENDOR and any subcontractor performing work under this Agreement from claims of bodily injury or property damage which arise from operations whether such operations are performed by the VENDER or anyone directly or indirectly employed by it. The amounts of such insurance shall not be less than ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) bodily injury each occurrence/aggregate and ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) property damage each occurrence/aggregate or ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) bodily injury and property damage combined single limits each occurrence/aggregate. The insurance shall include coverage for products/completed operations, personal injury liability, and contractual liability.
