

Town of Cornelius Greenway Rules & Regulations

Permitted:

- Bicycles
- Jogging
- Roller skates
- Skateboards
- Walking
- Manual and electric wheelchairs

Not Permitted:

- Concealed handguns or any other gun or firearm unless they are in strict compliance with applicable N.C. statutes and permits
- Collection, removal, damage or disturbance of town property, natural resources, or cultural objects
- Gas or electric powered scooters, motorcycles, golf carts and personal mobility devices
- Any other item constituting a weapon under applicable N.C. statutes
- Depositing refuse or trash generated outside of the premises
- Selling, soliciting, or exhibiting wares without a permit
- Operation of any unauthorized motorized vehicle
- Parking on the path or in undesignated areas
- Unapproved commercial or political signs
- Fireworks without a Town issued permit
- Facility use after posted hours
- Feeding or disturbing wildlife
- Airborne vehicles of any type
- Registered sex offenders
- Tobacco use of any kind
- Fuel-powered models
- Criminal activity
- Littering
- Hunting
- Golfing



Helmets: All bicyclists and roller skaters are encouraged to wear a helmet and protective gear. Children 16 years of age and younger are required to wear a helmet when riding a bicycle or rollerblading.

Pets: Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times. Leashes may not be any longer than 6 feet in length. Please pick up after your pet and dispose of the waste properly.

Safety: For your safety, always walk, jog, or ride with a friend. Please secure your valuables in a vehicle or leave them at home. Please stay on the paved path at all times
